• Each team can enter as many kids in the event, although a maximum of four swimmers from each team may swim in the finals of each individual event.

• Each school may enter up to 2 teams in each relay. Only the top team FROM EACH TEAM WILL BE SWUM AND SCORED in the finals. Top 18 relays will be swum in the finals...one from each school.

• Relays must be declared at least 15 minutes before the start of the meet.

• All events will be swum slowest to fastest in prelims.

• This is a Prelim/Finals meet- The fastest 18 swimmers, top 18 Divers after 8 dives and 18 relay teams in each event will compete on Saturday afternoon

• If a relay team or athlete chooses to NOT participate in finals, we would like for the athlete/relay team let the table know by end of the meet on Friday night or Diving Session on Saturday AM to give the next boy/team a chance to participate.

• Top 18 boys/relay teams will score points. 1-6 Finals, 7-12 Consolation AND places 13-18 bonus heat will be scored.

• Each boy will be allowed to swim in up to 4 events, of which no more than two can be individual events.

Diving: Divers will perform 11 dives following the championship meet format. Depending on the number of divers – we will dive 8 rounds in the AM session, then finish the final 3 dives during finals. Again, depending on the number of divers, diving cuts will be made to 22 after 5 rounds and then to 18 after 8 rounds complete. **Submit Dive list by Friday 6 PM. Dives may be changed on the day of the meet.**
